Meet Ruby

Ruby is a 10 year old male child. He likes wearing dresses and has long hair. That's OK. Ruby uses a 'girly' name (his official name is Ryan).

The gender clinic advised Ruby's parents to affirm Ruby's belief that he is a girl.

Ruby's parents tell everyone he is a girl and he uses female-only toilets at school, wears the girl's uniform and goes to sleep-overs with girls.

When Ruby starts puberty, **he will be given an experimental drug called 'Lupron' that will prevent development of his healthy brain, bones, and sex organs.** It is likely that Ruby will grow up to be infertile and never experience sexual functioning when he reaches adulthood.

Ruby may have grown up to be a gay man like many other children with gender dysphoria. But now he does not have the chance.

80-90% of children gender dysphoria will desist after puberty
